## OFFICE OF FOREIGN ASSETS CONTROL REPORT OF LICENSING ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO THE TRADE SANCTIONS REFORM AND EXPORT ENHANCEMENT ACT OF 2000

## April - June 2012

This report is submitted pursuant to Section 906(b) of the Trade Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000 ("TSRA") and covers activities undertaken by the Treasury Department's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC") under Section 906(a)(1) of the TSRA from April through June 2012. Under the procedures established in its TSRA-related regulations, OFAC processes license applications requesting authorization to export agricultural commodities, medicine, and medical devices to Iran and Sudan under the one-year specific licensing regime set forth in Section 906 of the TSRA.

From April 1 through June 30, 2012, OFAC's Licensing Division received a total of 371 applications pursuant to Section 906(a)(1) of the TSRA. During this period, OFAC issued a total of 536 licensing determinations,<sup>1</sup> of which 207 were for cases received in this quarter. OFAC issued 328 licenses, 79 license amendments, 44 "return-without-action" letters, and one denial letter in this quarter. Of the total licenses issued, 305 involved products for Iran and 23 for Sudan. For more details, see Charts 1-3 and Graph 1.
