CUBAN ASSETS CONTROL REGULATIONS

31 CFR PART 515

GENERAL LICENSE

Certain Travel-Related Transactions in Cuba Until 12:01 a.m.
Eastern Daylight Time on August 1, 2004

(a) Family visit travelers. A person subject to the jurisdiction of the United States who is in Cuba on June 29, 2004, under a general or specific license to visit a close relative in Cuba pursuant to 31 C.F.R. § 515.561(a) or (b) as in effect on June 29, 2004, is authorized to continue to engage in all of the transactions ordinarily incident to travel within and from Cuba authorized on June 29, 2004, until 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time on August 1, 2004.

(b) Fully-hosted travelers. A person subject to the jurisdiction of the United States who is in Cuba on June 29, 2004, and qualifies as a "fully-hosted" traveler as set forth in 31 C.F.R. § 515.420 as in effect on June 29, 2004, is authorized to continue to receive goods and services in Cuba for personal use or consumption in Cuba until 12:01 a.m. Eastern Daylight Time on August 1, 2004, provided that no person subject to the jurisdiction of the United States (including the traveler) makes any payment, transfers any property, or provides any service to Cuba or a national of Cuba in connection with the receipt of those goods or services.
