**Executive Order 13566 of February 25, 2011
Blocking Property and Prohibiting Certain Transactions Related to Libya**

GENERAL LICENSE NO. 3

Authorizing Provision of Certain Legal Services

(1) The provision of the following legal services to or on behalf of the Government of Libya, its agencies, instrumentalities, and controlled entities, including the Central Bank of Libya, or any other person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to Executive Order 13566 of February 25, 2011 ("E.O. 13566"), is authorized, provided that all receipts of payment of professional fees and reimbursement of incurred expenses must be specifically licensed:

- (a) Provision of legal advice and counseling on the requirements of and compliance with the laws of the United States or any jurisdiction within the United States, provided that such advice and counseling are not provided to facilitate transactions in violation of E.O. 13566;
- (b) Representation of persons named as defendants in or otherwise made parties to domestic U.S. legal, arbitration, or administrative proceedings;
- (c) Initiation and conduct of legal, arbitration, or administrative proceedings before any U.S. federal, state, or local court or agency;
- (d) Representation of persons before any federal or state agency with respect to the imposition, administration, or enforcement of U.S. sanctions against such persons; and
- (e) Provision of legal services in any other context in which prevailing U.S. law requires access to legal counsel at public expense.

(2) The provision of any other legal services to the Government of Libya, its agencies, instrumentalities, and controlled entities, including the Central Bank of Libya, or any other person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to E.O. 13566, not otherwise authorized by this General License No. 3, requires the issuance of a specific license.

(3) Entry into a settlement agreement or the enforcement of any lien, judgment, arbitral award, decree, or other order through execution, garnishment, or other judicial process purporting to transfer or otherwise alter or affect property or interests in property blocked pursuant to E.O. 13566 is prohibited unless licensed.
