Iranian Transactions and Sanctions Regulations 31 C.F.R. Part 560

GENERAL LICENSE F

Authorizing Certain Services in Support of Professional and Amateur Sports Activities and Exchanges Involving the United States and Iran

(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this general license, the importation of Iranianorigin services into the United States or other dealing in such services, and the exportation or reexportation of services, directly or indirectly, from the United States or by a United States person related to professional and amateur sporting activities and exchanges involving the United States and Iran are authorized, including, but not limited to, activities related to exhibition matches and events, the sponsorship of players, coaching, refereeing, and training.

(b) This general license does not authorize the exportation or reexportation of services specified in section (a) of this general license to any person whose property and interests in property are blocked pursuant to any part of 31 C.F.R. chapter V other than part 560.

Note 1 to General License F: United States depository institutions or United States registered brokers or dealers in securities are authorized to process transfers of funds in furtherance of activities authorized by this general license so long as the transfer is consistent with 31 C.F.R. § 560.516.

Note 2 to General License F: This general license does not authorize any transaction by a U.S.-owned or -controlled foreign entity otherwise prohibited by 31 C.F.R. § 560.215 if the transaction would be prohibited by any other part of chapter V if engaged in by a U.S. person or in the United States.
