GENERAL LICENSE NO. 1

Authorizing the Wind Down of Transactions Involving Entities Blocked on November 18, 2024

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (b) of this general license, all transactions prohibited by Executive Order (E.O.) 14115 that are ordinarily incident and necessary to the wind down of any transaction involving Amana The Settlement Movement Of Gush Emunim Central Cooperative Association Ltd (Amana), Binyanei Bar Amana Ltd (BBA), or any entity in which Amana or BBA owns, directly or indirectly, individually or in the aggregate, a 50 percent or greater interest, are authorized through 12:01 a.m. eastern standard time, January 10, 2025, provided that any payment to a blocked person must be made into a blocked interest-bearing account and reported to the Office of Foreign Assets Control consistent with § 501.603 of the Reporting, Procedures and Penalties Regulations, 31 CFR part 501.
- (b) This general license does not authorize any transactions otherwise prohibited by E.O. 14115, including transactions involving any person blocked pursuant to E.O. 14115 other than the blocked persons described in paragraph (a) of this general license, unless separately authorized.
