



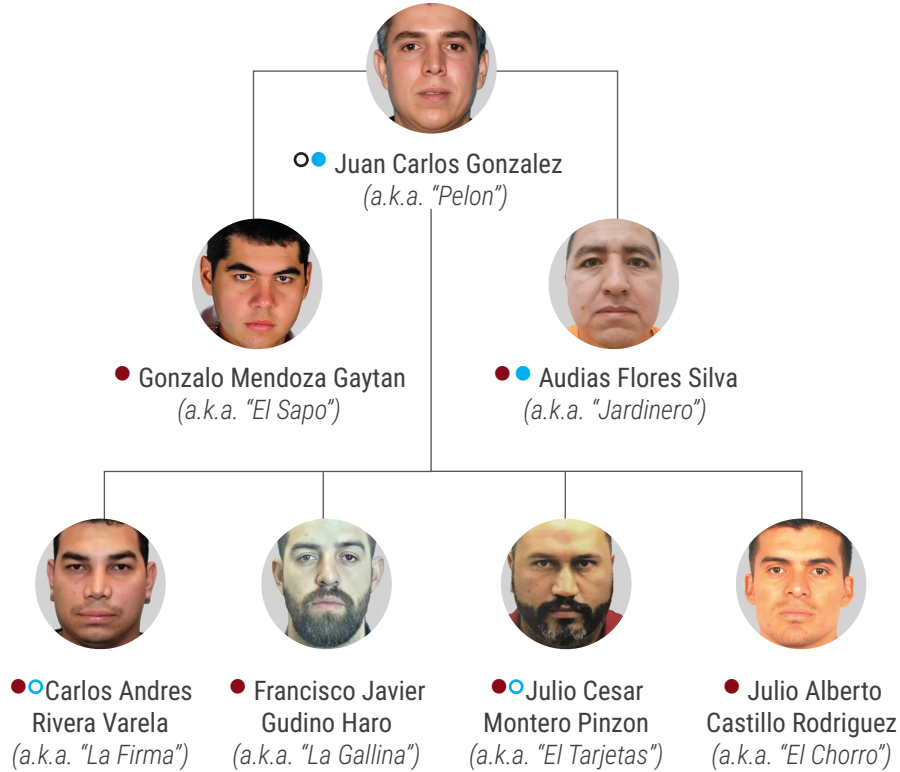

CJNG Activities

Drug Trafficking

- Responsible for a significant portion of fentanyl and other deadly drugs trafficked to the United States

Violence and Corruption

- Assassinates rivals and government officials
- Bribes government officials

Illicit Finance

- Develops alternative revenue streams, including fuel theft and smuggling, extortion, and timeshare fraud
- Launders drug and other criminal proceeds
- Holds cartel-related assets through complicit family members and trusted associates
